The Department of Pediatrics at CHEO, University of Ottawa is recruiting a full-time Gastroenterologist with a focus on Inflammatory Bowel Diseases within the Division of Gastroenterology, Hepatology and Nutrition. The ideal candidate will have demonstrated leadership potential and evidence of a strong track record in clinical or basic research in pediatric Crohn's disease and/or ulcerative colitis.

The Division also provides a comprehensive array of clinical services in intestinal and liver disease and encompasses a multidisciplinary team of allied health professionals consisting of nurses, dietitians, and a dedicated social worker.

The Department of Pediatrics is affiliated with Children's Hospital of Eastern Ontario (CHEO), the CHEO Research Institute and the University of Ottawa.
