Yorkton Regional Health Centre is the only regional hospital in the southeast, offering exposure to a wide range of pediatric cases without the congestion of a large urban centre.

The pediatric team is supported by a comprehensive range of services including pediatric therapies, autism spectrum disorder services, early childhood psychology, mental health, social work, dental services, and public health nursing. Strong connections with community-based supports such as KidsFirst and school-based programs ensure integrated, family-centered care.

Itinerant pediatric services may be required throughout the southeast portion of the province through on-site or telemedicine services.

Those currently in pediatric residency are encouraged to inquire about The Health Foundation of East Central Saskatchewan's Resident Funding Program in exchange for a return of service.

Yorkton offers a rewarding practice environment, strong community connection, and balanced lifestyle—ideal for pediatricians looking to make a meaningful impact in children's health while enjoying a high quality of life.
