With a population approaching 100,000, Prince George is the largest city in Northern BC. Located at the confluence of the Fraser and Nechako rivers, the community is home to the University of Northern British Columbia (UNBC), known as “Canada’s Green University.”

About the role

The Pediatrician will provide pediatric care at the University Hospital of Northern British Columbia (UHNBC), the regional referral centre for Northern BC. The role includes inpatient and outpatient pediatrics, newborn and Level II B NICU care, emergency consultations, and developmental and behavioural assessments, supported by a strong regional referral base.

The successful candidate will join a collegial team of General Pediatricians and participate in on-call coverage. Applicants must be comfortable providing neonatal and pediatric hospital-based care, with opportunities to develop focused interests that complement departmental needs.

The position offers opportunities for interdisciplinary collaboration, involvement in teaching medical students and residents through the UBC Northern Medical Program, and participation in outreach and visiting specialist clinics within Northern Health communities.



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
