THE POSITION

It also leads Holland Bloorview's academic mission through the Teaching and Learning Institute, the relationship with the Temerty Faculty of Medicine, and partnership with the Bloorview Research Institute and TAHSN.

As Holland Bloorview expands its physician complement through the Alternate Funding Plan, the role combines internal clinical leadership with a strong external dimension: representing Holland Bloorview across TAHSNm Medical and TAHSNe Education tables, with Ontario's children's hospitals and the University of Toronto, and in the advocacy that shapes the wider system. It is an opportunity to anchor and communicate Holland Bloorview's leadership in child and youth disability nationally and internationally.
