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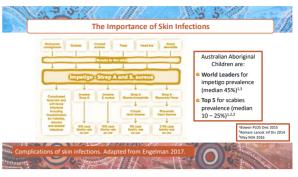

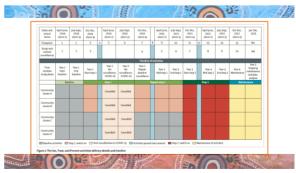


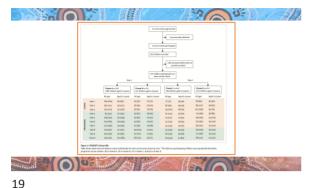

Throughout the Trial, communities and service providers highlighted that to keep skin healthy it is critical to keep the environment that we live in healthy.

People spoke highly of environmental health support, but described barriers to accessing a healthy environment in the home and community.

The importance of housing & environmental health

"It is more down to the Government colonisation and housing. You can't really
do much if your living conditions don't change and nothing ever gets put into
housing...This is empirical knowledge right across Australia. That is where the
problems lie... It has always put that they choose to be like that rather than it is
actually an imposed system that has been placed on them. You can't heal
yourself in that setting and you wouldn't expect other people in this country to.'

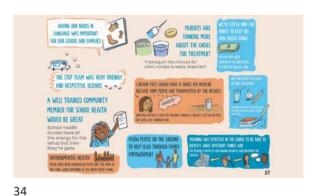
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
