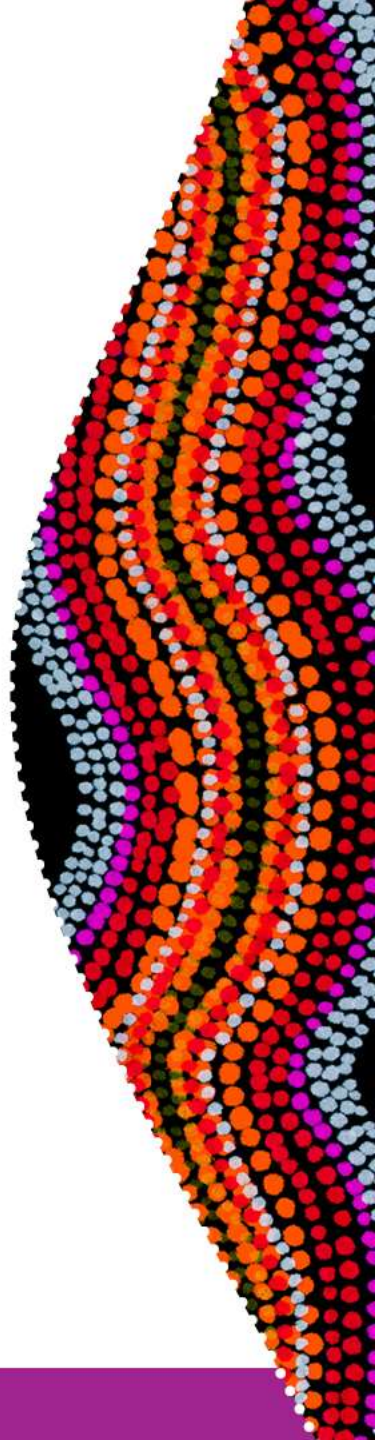

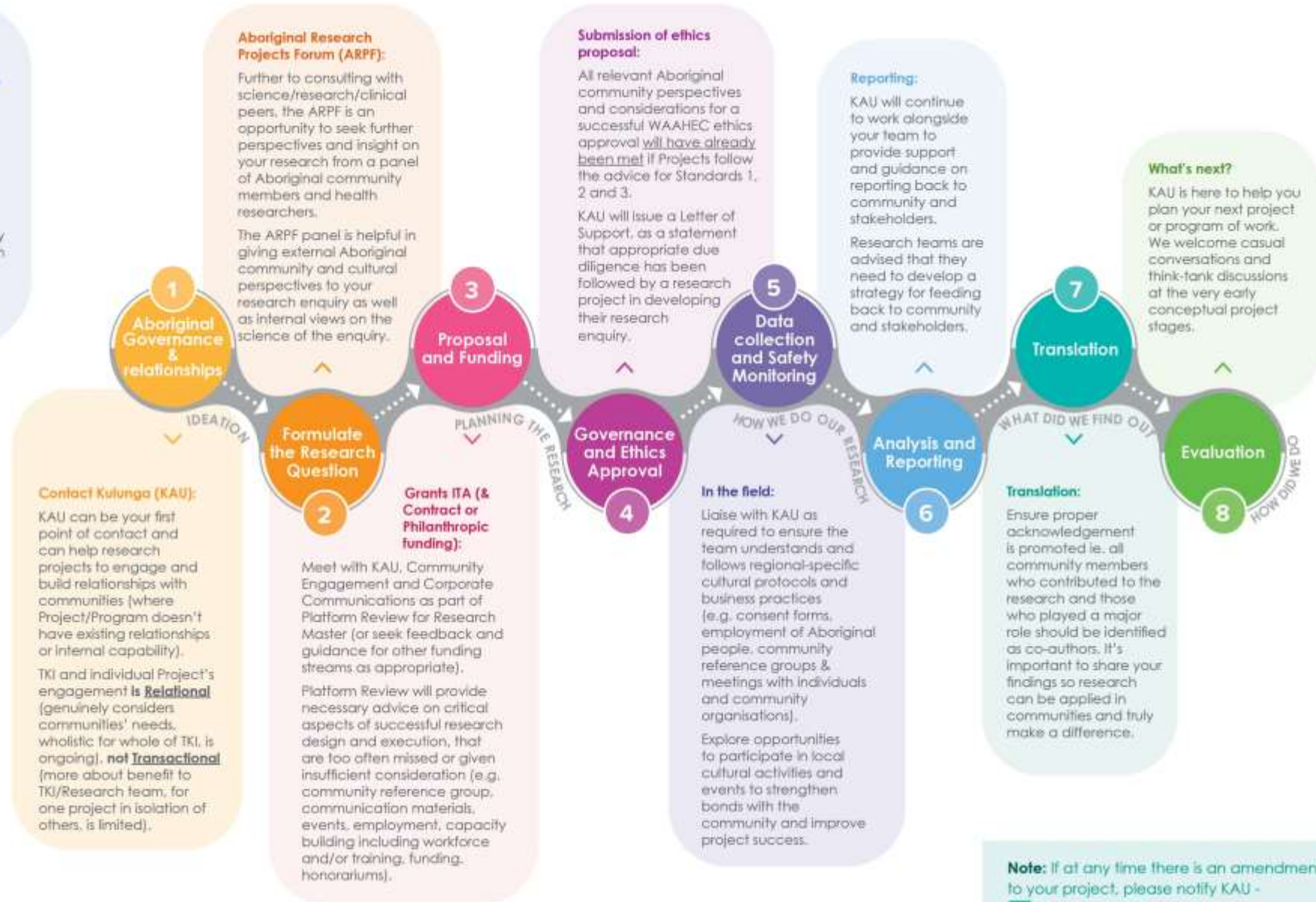




Research Idea
